Abstract Submission Guidelines

Abstract with name and affiliation of authors should be organized in a page as given below.

Title of the paper (Centre alignment, upper case, font size 12, bold).

Name(s) and address(es) of the author(s) (Centre alignment, title case, font size 12, names alone bold). The name of the presenter should be underlined in the author list.

The abstract should be submitted with a maximum of 250-300 words comprising of brief background, methods, results, conclusion and keywords. It should be in Microsoft Word with Times New Roman, font size 12, with a line space of 1.15.

Poster Preparation Guidelines

Poster (1 x 1.2 m) should include title, name(s) and affiliation(s) of the author(s), brief introduction, materials and methods, results and conclusions. The presenter's name should be underlined, and the email address given.

Recognition of Outstanding Achievements

Awards will be conferred for the best oral and poster presentations in each session of the conference. Awards will also be conferred under various categories such as Young Scientist, Best Scientist, Women Scientist, Lifetime Achievement, Fellowship, etc. The guidelines for the awards are available on www.jasa-islands.org & formats have been enclosed with brochure.
